

## Eradicating Through Forgiveness

***Above all things have intense and unflinching love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and disregards the offenses of others]. Practice hospitality to one another (those of the household of faith). [Be hospitable, be a lover of strangers, with brotherly affection for the unknown guests, the foreigners, the poor, and all others who come your way who are of Christ's body.] And [in each instance] do it ungrudgingly (cordially and graciously, without complaining but as representing Him). 1 Peter 4:8-9 AMP***

Life is full of uncertainties and there are things that have happened to each one of us that sometime leaves long term scarring. Also we could have attempted to rid ourselves of the mass of the situation or situations, but yet there remains residue.

**Residue** - the remainder of something after removal of parts or a part.

Residue is the part that the enemy tries to use in our lives as believers, to keep us bound in our minds, divide in our relationships with one another. Though the mass has been removed, but the residue has the ability to still hinder us from progressing the way we desire.

Consider is there anything or anyone that has hurt you, scared you and it has taken time for you to recover. Even though it is a past situation it has prevalence in your present. You have prayed about it and yet it seems as though it is deeply embedded in your spirit, (***like a red Kool-Aid stain in a white carpet***). The main part of the spot is gone, but there is a shadow that reminds you of what was. It is not that you are trying to hold on to it, but it is like it want turn you loose.

Take today and do what Jesus suggested for us. Forgive.

**Maybe you have forgiven them, maybe you have prayed about it, but the true power of forgiveness is being able to continuously forgive until you have power over the situation and the situation no longer over powers you. Keep forgiving until if you think about it, there is no pain, there is no emotional abnormality that accrues.**

**Forgive** and be Healed, **Forgive** and be free, **Forgive** that you might minister the same Power of Forgiveness to someone else.

**We may not be the one who caused the issue, but we have the power of deliverance through FORGIVENESS, that causes our prayers to go unhindered.**

**And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him *and* let it drop (leave it, let it go), in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you your [own] failings *and* shortcomings *and* let them drop.**
