

Empowering Men and Women For their God-Given Assignment

II Corinthians 10: 3-6 - Luke 10:19

Empowering (empower) - to invest with power; especially legal power or official authority; to authorize; to equip or supply with an ability; to enable

For - used to indicate the object of a desire, intention, or perception: indicating appropriateness or suitability

Assignment (assign) - to select for a duty or office; to appoint; to set apart for a particular purpose or place in a particular category; to designate; to match or pair with.

Our actions and reactions all have an origin, but the origin from which they surface we cannot always identify.

We desire to go higher, we want to be and do better, but there is an unexplainable operation in our flesh called desire (carnality), that we have a problem containing.

Note: No One can ever conquer the flesh (fallen nature/carnality) outside of Christ (Galatians 5:16-17)

We suffer from a generational chronicity that passed on from Adams disobedience/fall in the Garden of Eden

- **Generation** – denotes the origin, lineage, birth from which the offspring share a common ancestor.
- **Chronicity** - Subject to a habit or pattern of behavior for a long time; continuing for a long time; constantly recurring.

We are victims of a fallen nature inherited from Adam when he disobeyed God's order. (Romans 5:18-19)

Sin disconnects us from the true source of life and life becomes a vacuum of futility; until we reconnect to the source of life.

Note: What God has given us does not need to be altered for the times we live in; it will actually alter the time in which we live when it is properly executed.

Isaiah 50:4 - 1 Chronicles 12:32

1 Peter 1:3-4 AMP

³ Blessed [gratefully praised and adored] be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant and boundless mercy has caused us to be born again [that is, to be reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, and set apart for His purpose] to an ever-living hope and confident assurance through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

⁴ [born anew] into an inheritance which is imperishable [beyond the reach of change] and undefiled and unfading, reserved in heaven for you,

- **We now have the nature of God (born again, restored). We do not supersede God, but we now walk in our God given authority given at our origin. Remember the seed of God sown in our hearts is to produce the desired outcome of God's purpose. Peter speaks of the restorative work of God through Jesus Christ and that what Christ has done cannot be undone.**

We Are Supernaturally Empowered

- **Supernatural** - attributed to a power that seems to violate or go beyond natural forces.
- **Natural** - conforming to the usual or ordinary course of nature: that which is in accordance with human nature
- Even though the term supernatural is never used in scripture, but is plainly referenced/noted through the use of words -Holy Ghost, Holy Spirit or Spirit of God.

It is amazing how we tend to accept what we see as final, but what we see does not agree with what God has spoken or shown us and it certainly disagrees with God's Word (Logos).

1. This level of mindset comes from trying to walk in our own strength.
Proverbs 23:17; Romans 12:1-2
 2. Seeing things from a carnal or the fallen nature (which is a defeated nature). Genesis 3:10-11
 3. Rather than seeing things supernaturally (this is a faith nature, born of God, which mirrors the nature of God). Hebrews 11:1-3
- **There are things about you that the adversary does not want you to discover.**
 - **There are things you are to accomplish for the Kingdom of God that the devil does not want you to pursue.**

Note: God assures the success of our God given assignment, it is not predicated on how inadequate we feel or see ourselves. It is based on what God has invested in us and God's Promise to fulfill what He has ordained.

Exodus 7:8-12 - Jeremiah 1:7-12 - Isaiah 55:11- Philippians 1:6

1. Everywhere we go and everything we do as believer's set precedence in the earth. Joshua 1:3
2. We bring order, where there is disorder; we bring peace where there is chaos. . Isaiah 58:
3. Everything about us, reflects the Kingdom of God in us for He is our King.
2 Corinthians 5:20

Note: If He is our King then we are under His sovereign ruler ship. The King is responsible for the kingdom and everyone that has committed to their allegiants to Him.

So everything that *we are (I am), must be (is)* in pursuit of who God is.

Psalms 42:1

1. We are not under demonic influence, the devil does not dictate to our life.
Mark 16:17
2. Sin has no more dominion over us; the curse of sin is broken and destroyed. Romans 6:12-18;8:1

3. Every generational curse before our relationship with/in Christ is denounced and cast down. 2 Corinthians 10:4-6

This does not mean at all that what we may be facing is not real, but as children of God we have supernatural authority in the face of extreme circumstance. (Exodus 14)

- We are born again (from above). John 3:3 ;1 Peter 1:23
- We have been blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 1:3
- We have been translated in to the Kingdom of God through Jesus Christ. Colossians 1:13

We I take dominion of this earthly realm and take authority over principalities and powers, rulers of darkness and spiritual wickedness in high places through the Power of God given me through Christ Jesus according to the Promise of God

Ephesians 3:14-19 AMP

¹⁴ For this reason [grasping the greatness of this plan by which Jews and Gentiles are joined together in Christ] I bow my knees [in reverence] before the Father [of our Lord Jesus Christ], ¹⁵ from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name [God—the first and ultimate Father]. ¹⁶ May He grant you out of the riches of His glory, to be strengthened and spiritually energized with power through His Spirit in your inner self, [indwelling your innermost being and personality], ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through your faith. And may you, having been [deeply] rooted and [securely] grounded in love, ¹⁸ be fully capable of comprehending with all the saints (God’s people) the width and length and height and depth of His love [fully experiencing that amazing, endless love]; ¹⁹ and [that you may come] to know [practically, through personal experience] the love of Christ which far surpasses [mere] knowledge [without experience], that you may be filled up [throughout your being] to all the fullness of God [so that you may have the richest experience of God’s presence in your lives, completely filled and flooded with God Himself].
